Giving and receiving flowers or plants shouldn't induce anxiety! If you're not sure whether a pet can be trusted around house plants, or if you're giving a plant or bouquet as a gift, consider choosing from among any of the following non-toxic plants and flowers.

If you are picking out a bouquet, don't forget to check that the filler leaves and flowers are pet-safe too!

Roses, Sunflowers, Orchids, African Violets, African Daisies (Gerber Daisies, Osteospermum), and Zinnias.

PET SAFE BOUQUET FILLER FLOWERS

Fern fronds, Baby's Breath, Celosia, Lilac (leaves and flowers), Globe Thistle, Snap Dragons, Asters and Bachelors Buttons.
